

The Bilkent Symphony Orchestra Announces Auditions for The Following Full-time Positions

1st movement with cadenza from one of the following:

- **Tutti Violin Two positions** Mozart KV 218 or KV 219
- Tutti Viola Two positions
 Stamitz or Hoffmeister Concerto in D
- Tutti Violoncello
 Haydn Concerto in C or in D
- **Tutti Double Bass** Dittersdorf Concerto in E Major or Vaňhal Concerto in D Major
- Principal Bassoon
 Mozart B-flat Major KV 191
- Tutti French Horn Two positions
 Mozart KV 447 or KV 495

The first round of the audition will be by pre-selection video. Submission Deadline is **Friday**, **February 3, 2023.** The recording must be filmed with a single camera and both player and instrument must be visible throughout. Post-processing of sound and/or video is prohibited and the recording must be a single, uncut take. In the recording you should aim for high quality sound and image.

Do not send the video as an attachment but upload to an internet streaming service (Youtube etc.). Check also that the video opens directly without the need for a password. If the applicant fails to attach video the application will not be valid and will not be considered.

Mozart KV 218 or KV 219 and Brahms, Mendelssohn, Sibelius, Tchaikovsky

Viola

Stamitz or **Hoffmeister Concerto in D** and **Bartók - Viola Concerto** Hindemith - Der Schwanendreher Schubert - Arpeggione Sonata D.821

Violoncello

. Haydn Concerto in C or in D and Dvořák Op. 104 or Schumann Op. 129

Double Bass

Dittersdorf Concerto in E Major or **Vaňhal Concerto in D Major** and **Bottesini Concerto No 2 in B Minor** or **Koussevitzky Concerto Op. 3**

Bassoon

Mozart B-flat Major KV 191 and Saint-Saëns Sonata for bassoon and piano

Horn

Mozart KV 447 or KV 495 and Strauss Concerto No. 1
